On December 4th, Grand Knight Rob McAnnar of Council <u>6629</u>, Summerville, joined Joy Yarborough, CEO of Lowcountry Pregnancy Center, located at 7481 Northside Drive, Charleston, SC for the celebration of the installation of the State's 24th Ultrasound Unit.

Studies show that most women considering abortion will change their mind and choose life after having an Ultrasound where a live image of the child can be seen, and a heartbeat can be heard. Initially, in 2019, spearheaded by Council Life Director, John Starzyk, the Richard C. Madden Council #6629 began a "Baby Bottle Drive" to begin their fund raising so that the Low Country Pregnancy Center would be able to acquire an additional Ultrasound machine.

The Lowcountry Pregnancy center expects that over 180 pregnant women will choose life after having an Ultrasound from this unit.

Beginning with the bottle drive as a foundation, Parish Respect Life Committee and the council Knights of Columbus were at all Masses collecting donations. Over time, between the bottle campaign and other donations, over \$14,000 was generated for this worthy cause.

The Supreme Council of Knights of Columbus, headquartered in New Haven, CT, supports local councils generating funds for Ultrasound machines and donates matching 50% of the machine cost toward councils for their acquisitions.

Ultrasound Machine Brings New Life To Lowcountry Pregnancy Center

Since 1986 the Lowcountry Pregnancy Center has been transforming the lives of families in the Charleston area with over 137,000 pregnancy and parenting related client service visits. They operate three centers, two in the Charleston area and one in Orangeburg.
