As we have mentioned earlier, despite COVID protocols, multiple councils around the state are at 100% of their recruiting goal or expected to EXCEED it by June 30th. Councils **2207, 5086, 6726, 6892, 9575, 11471, 11910, 11991, 12472, and 16903** are showing that you can recruit during COVID.

For the first time since 2014-2015, our state has a chance to **earn the Circle of Honor**. **We have 30 days to recruit 30 members around the state**. We do not recruit for awards but for the future of our councils. This holds true for the future of our state! Can we not inspire 30 Catholic gentlemen to join us so the Light of Christ remains bright in South Carolina? *I say we can and will*. What say you?

Councils are meeting again....

There are many councils that are meeting in person. For example Seneca 6884 combined face-to-face and on-line for 32 total in April. Council 9575 Spartanburg had 33 at their May meeting with 2 on-line. 9575 resumed live meeting 2 months ago. Blessed Trinity 12274 in Greer had 19 at their April meeting. Large and small councils alike are returning to live meetings. Check with your Pastor as each church seems to have different COVID protocols in effect. If you can't meet at church, what about an outdoor venue? Remember, Fraternity works better when we can be with each other.
