Unfortunately, due to the pandemic, our brothers from Canada and Europe were not able to join us in person although they did attend virtually.

The highlight of the event was to witness the Installation of our Supreme Knight together with the other first-year Supreme Officers, Directors, and State Deputies. To be in the same church where our founder, Blessed Michael McGivney preached was a surreal experience. To be able to stand by his tomb was something I will treasure forever.

During the course of the five days in New Haven we had the opportunity to hear the message of our new Supreme Knight Patrick E. Kelly and our Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori as well as hearing from many of the Directors and key members of the Supreme Staff who will be leading us this fraternal year. Throughout the entire event, the mission was clear — we are here in this time and place for a purpose: so what is your purpose? What is your story? What is it that prompted you to become a member of the largest Catholic fraternal organization in the world? And more importantly, what is it that keeps you as a member? These are questions that only we ourselves can answer. And it is in answering them that we will be able to invite other men to become part of our brotherhood.

As our churches begin to open and life returns to somewhat normal, we as Knights have an important mission. Our number one priority must be to work with our Pastors and ask how we can help get folks back to church. We have a calling to evangelize and that evangelization must begin within our own parish family.

Brothers, I am excited about the new fraternal year. I am excited about expanding our communication efforts and being able to meet with as many of you as possible. I encourage you to invite all State Officers to as many of your council events

From the Vocations Director

Keep the faith alive by supporting our seminarians and postulants. As the strong right arm of the church, we are committed to providing moral, financial and spiritual support to our future priests and religious at all stages of their formation. The Refund Support Vocations Program (RSVP) counts for two credits toward the Columbian Award.

We stand in solidarity with our priests and religious. Through this program, council and parish families raise funds to support seminarians. For every \$500 given to an individual, the Supreme Council will refund the council or assembly \$100. The maximum refund a council or assembly can receive is \$400 per individual supported. Though financial support is vitally important, it is not the only aspect of the RSVP. Councils are also called to provide their "adopted" seminarian or religious aspirant with moral support and prayers for their success.

Your support and prayers provide a life-line to our seminarians. The closest seminary to our diocese is over 400 miles away, so it is difficult for them to get back except on holidays. The contact you provide them reminds them that we are praying for their vocation and they appreciate your cards and letters from the council or assembly.

Supreme made some changes to the RSVP program last year. Councils can receive refunds if the seminarian is an American studying in the US or abroad. Foreign seminarians can be supported if they are studying in the US. Supreme will no longer issue refunds if foreign seminarians are studying in their home country or abroad.

Last year was a strange year for vocations. We started the year with 10 seminarians entering the program. Six men requested a leave of absence and must remain out of the program for at least 12 months. The following have been granted a leave of absence: Pedro Silva, Sebastian Barbosa-Garcia, Nicholas Shiver, Mario Aguilar, Enerson Hernandez, and Mauricio Moreno. Father Rafael Ghattas was ordained last month in the Cathedral in Charleston.

With 7 men leaving the program this year and 2-3 coming in, it will be important to check with me before committing to supporting a seminarian. The vocation office normally does not release the names of seminarians until the end of August after the new seminarians have started classes. I will keep track of your support so that we can make sure that the seminarians that need the support the most are getting it. Your support is greatly appreciated by the vocation office, seminarians and me.

Many of our councils here in South Carolina lost members due to COVID 19 and other illnesses. Many of our councils struggled to gain any new members or have any programs completed. I am proud to say that several of our councils pressed on despite this pandemic and had a positive growth in membership and were able to continue to plan and implement a successful Faith in Action program. Having successful programs is key to a council's survival and growth. It is when we conduct an effective Faith in Action program throughout the fraternal year that others in our church communities will see what the Knights of Columbus is all about and want to become part of us. We have strong State Faith in Action Directors this year to help guide your program directors to conduct effective programs. Our State Family Director is John Olson, GK, State Faith Director is Deacon Robert Cox, PGK, FDD, State Community Director is Joe Mule, PGK, and our State Life Director is Chris Carter, DW. These brother knights are dedicated to ensuring that the councils within our state have a strong understanding of the Faith in Action programs, where to find resources, and how to implement them. From the State Protocol Chairman

PROTOCOL

Worthy Grand Knights, Faithful Navigators and Members of the State Council:

INVITATIONS

Guests should be sent proper invitations in writing well in advance. Invitations should be mailed at least six weeks before an event. This will afford ample time to respond to the invitation.

All invitations should be sent in the name of and signed by the Grand Knight or Faithful Navigator, although he may request that replies be directed to a chairman or committee member. The District Deputy, as the special representative of the Supreme Knight and the State Deputy, should be invited to special Council or Assembly functions. It should be understood that his schedule may not permit him to attend every affair, in which case he would respond in ample time. Never give a blanket invitation to anyone. Always send each guest a personal invitation. If tickets are being used for a function, they should be forwarded, suitably marked, along with the invitation.

Invitations should be in the form of a letter when addressed to a specific person. Printed cards or general invitation notices may be used if the occasion warrants. A bulletin or flyer may be enclosed with the invitation if it gives more detailed information. It should not be used in lieu of an invitation. Such bulletins should never show the name of the person invited unless he has agreed to be present.

When an invitation is extended to anyone it should contain all details such as dress, extent of participation, etc. It is embarrassing for a guest to appear and find that he is the only one at the head table not in a tuxedo, or the only one present wearing one.


