From the State Ceremonials/ Protocol Chairman

Worthy Grand Knights and Members of the State Council: The District Deputies Winter meeting has just completed and several items of interest were discussed that are of concern to all councils in the state. In the ceremonial area of the meeting it was discussed about the form 450 and 450C, the filling out of the form and its distribution. The form 450C is no longer a valid form and if used should be sent within state only for State Deputy and Ceremonial Chairman Information only. The Form 450 is to be filled out by the District Deputy and forwarded to Supreme Council, State Deputy and the State Ceremonial Chairman. The form must be filled out completely for all degrees and for the Formation (2nd) Degree must have the word "New" on the staff name line if the new Formation Degree is conferred, this is the only way that the new Cross can be replaced when used during the degree. The Cross replacement will be sent to the Formation Degree team captain of record. To change the team captain for any Formation Degree team a request must be sent to the State Ceremonial Chairman.

The charge of \$7.00 has been eliminated for the Knighthood Degree and a charge of \$5.50 per member taking the Knighthood Degree is assessed to each council with members making the Knighthood Degree with the check or cash being made out to "Knights of Columbus State Council". This check or cash is to be given to either the State Deputy or the State Ceremonial Chairman with the information as to which council the money is from. All Knighthood Degrees will start at 12:30 unless otherwise stated in the District Deputy's notification letter for the degree.

A new MOU is in place for the Knighthood Degree and all District Deputies have been given a copy of the letter. If you

want a copy of the MOU you can request it from the State Ceremonial Chairman. This MOU is to be signed at least one month prior to the Degree being held and a copy returned to the State Ceremonial Chairman.

For a Council or District to receive credit for a degree held the District Deputy must submit a Form 450 to Supreme, State Deputy and the Ceremonial Chairman. Be sure the Degree held is clearly marked on the form along with location held and date the degree was conducted. Until this form is received by the Ceremonial Chairman, the status record will not change in the report. Any Form 450's received after the 9th of each month will not be recorded until the next month's newsletter. The attached reports show the status of each council for Admission Degrees and the District Formation Degrees for 2016 – 2017 **THIS REPORT DOES NOT SHOW MEMBERSHIP INTAKE FOR EACH COUNCIL.**

PROTOCOL

Introductions:

When at a meeting or function the Master of Ceremonies or senior officer should follow protocol and make all introductions. Members are introduced from the lowest position to the highest. They should be recognized by their full name and correct title (i.e. John Doe Past Grand Knight, Joe Smith Former Vice Supreme Master and Jack Brown Degree Team Conferring Officer). Remember to introduce all present at a function, meeting or degree as well as introducing those that are guests of the council or assembly and are not members of the Order. Be sure to get their proper title and order of precedence to others attending the function. When uncertain do not be afraid to ask for advice from your District Deputy or State Officer/Chairman.
